



Queer Apocalypse Solutions Homemade Cloth Corona Virus Mask

Here is a mask for you to wear when you leave the house during the current global queer apocalypse. As many states plan to re-open, do not forget that wearing a mask is not only about protecting you, but also about protecting your community.

This mask is NOT a medical grade mask. It is based on a pattern distributed by Johns Hopkins Medical Center.

This mask needs to be washed after each use. Do not toggle it on and off when wearing as whatever specks of virus may be on the outside will still get into your nasal cavity, eyes, and mouth. When you are done wearing this mask, remove it from the ear ties. DO NOT touch the front. Throw directly into the washing machine. Then wash your hands thoroughly.

Never, under any circumstances, touch your face.

The masks look great with all outfits and all gender expressions.

How to wear: Tie upper ribbons behind your head and lower ribbons behind your neck; or, alternately, tie left ribbons together behind left ear and repeat on the right, whatever serves your fancy.

Iron the masks to re-fresh the pleats and for added anti-viral action after each wash.
